Dolphin Cranium Instructions

Object: Be the first team to reach the dolphin in the center and successfully complete a series of three tasks.

Materials:

- 1 die
- 1 stopwatch
- 2 game pieces
- Play-DohTM
- Blank paper and a pencil

Directions:

- 1. Split up into two teams of two.
- 2. Select a game piece for your team and place it on the box labeled "Start".
- 3. The team with the person whose birthday is coming up next will start.
- 4. Select the type of task your team would like to complete.
- 5. The opposing team will draw your card and read the instructions aloud to you.
- 6. If you are not successful, your turn is over. If you do successfully complete the task, roll

Hint: You will be asked to complete a task at the **beginning** of your turn and roll at the **end** of your turn.

the die. Move your game piece the number of spaces indicated on your die. You must stop on each "Dolphin" space, even if your roll would otherwise take you past it. Your turn is now over. (The type of space you land on will specify the type of task you will be asked to complete during your next turn. If you land on a "Dolphin" space, you will be able to select the type of task your team will complete.)

- 7. The opposing team may now take their turn.
- 8. Once the opposing team has taken their turn, it is back to your team. Remember, the type of space your game piece is on specifies which type of task you will be asked to complete. A "dolphin" space means that you may choose the type of task your team will complete.
- 9. Proceed around the board until you reach the dolphin at the center.
- 10. On your team's next turn, you will need to successfully complete a task from **all three** categories. If you do not successfully complete all three tasks, leave your game piece at the center. During your next turn, you will again need to attempt a task from all three categories.
- 11. The first team to reach the center and successfully complete all three tasks is the winner!
