Grade Level: K-2nd

Objectives: In a creative way, students will apply their knowledge of operations (addition) and even and odd whole numbers and demonstrate the ability to follow directions.

Florida Sunshine State Standards:

Mathematics

MA.A.3.1.1 The student understands and explains the effects of addition and subtraction on whole numbers, including the inverse (opposite) relationship of the two operations. MA.A.5.1.1 The student classifies and models numbers as even or odd.

Background: This activity enables students to use their place value and addition skills to make a picture. Students should be familiar with even and odd numbers in order to complete their pictures.

Materials:

- Copies of the handout
- Pencils
- Crayons: blue & gray

Procedures:

- 1. Review even numbers and odd numbers
- 2. Practice some addition problems on the board
- 3. In pairs or individually, have students complete the handout.
- 4. Have them check their answers before they start coloring.

Wrap Up: Share work and pictures!

Taking it Further: Students could use this activity to make up their own pictures for the rest of the class to solve and color.
